**Municipal Development Plan (MDP)**- In early 2008 the 14 member steering committee was created. This committee holds the responsibility of creating a long term development plan for future growth within the MD. We are very grateful to Randy Gates and Theresa Berglund for the time and effort they have given in representing Division 6 for this project.

**Standards Bylaw** - The bylaw was approved by council in early fall. Amendments were required to reflect the diversity of our own community. Thank you to the residents that contributed suggestions and presented concerns. Many were incorporated into the bylaw.

## **Roads**

- Construction and paving was completed on 32 St. from Dunbow Rd. to Hwy.552.
- Dunbow Rd./ Heritage Lake Access. This was completed in late fall. It was years late and expensive, but I am sure we are all pleased to see it behind us.
- Completion of chip seal on 256 Ave. and 262 Ave. This brings us very close to having all MD roads gravel free in our division.

**Dunbow Recreation Board** – Approval was given by council to create this board for the purpose of building recreational facilities within our community. Some of the considerations include expanding the Heritage Heights School facilities, creating a facility at Heritage Lake and an additional ball diamond at Davisburg . The board members will be chosen in December and the inaugural meeting will take place in late December or early January. I look forward to working together with the board to achieve these much needed additions to our community.

**Calgary Regional Plan (CRP)** – This plan along with Minister Morton’s Land Use Plan and our own Municipal Plan will shape the future of our MD. I know many of you are interested in knowing what progress we are making with the CRP. I hope to host an open house early in the New Year to share information and gather opinions.
