RECREATION FACILITIES

The ball diamond and soccer field at Davisburg and Heritage Lake are nearing completion. All of the fields have been reseeded and any weeds will be addressed in the spring. The Scott Seaman Sports Rink at Heritage Heights held a Ground Breaking ceremony July 17, 2012. Construction is underway with completion slated for September 2013.

On September 29, 615 people enjoyed country cooking and over \$16,000 was raised for our recreation facilities. DEVELOPMENT

There have been a few applications for smaller country residential parcels, but the MD has not received any applications for major development in our area. MD staff is currently working on a Land use Strategy Plan that will give some direction on how and where growth will occur going forward. There will opportunities to contribute to this through open houses.

ROADS

The access from Artesia at Heritage Pointe on to Dunbow road is now complete with acceleration and deceleration lanes being constructed. Paving of 80st. is now completed and public works is resurfacing many of the roads in our area. Please let me know if you are aware of a road that requires surfacing or patching. Pine Creek road has been identified for paving in 2013 if budget allows.
